Piano Accompanist:

The Piano Accompanist is a part-time position within the worship and music programs of White Bluff Chapel in support of the Chapel's Mission Statement, Statement of Purpose and Statement of Faith.

The Piano Accompanist, in carrying out the responsibilities below, supports and is supervised by the Music Director with ultimate responsibility to the Staff Relations Committee. The division of accompaniment and other responsibilities between the Organ accompanist and the Piano Accompanist is at the discretion of the Music Director.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as pianist for Sunday and other worship services, including preludes, offertories, congregational hymns and any other required service music.
- Arrange for substitute (acceptable to the Music Director) if unable to fulfill responsibilities for any service or rehearsal.
- Provide accompaniment for the choir at Sunday and other worship services and rehearse with the choir at weekly and any additional rehearsals (if not providing primary accompaniment, be prepared to fill in, if necessary, at the request of the Music Director).
- Rehearse with and accompany soloists and ensembles providing special music for Sunday and other worship services.
- Report to the Music Director the condition and needs for maintenance of the church piano.
- Retain the second right of refusal (after the Organ Accompanist) to provide music for any wedding or funeral service being held at the Chapel for which music is desired, if the family does not have their own accompanist.
- Assist and support the Music Director in other areas to the extent requested.
